It consists of a total number of 31 digits, based on 24 codes included in 20 variables organised into 14 decision clusters, yielding 4 diagnoses.

It is based on the 8th edition of Emil Kraepelin's *Lehrbuch der Psychiatrie fur Studierende und Aerzte*, published from 1909 to 1915, in which mixed state depressive excitement is separated from manic depressive insanity paranoid depressive state, manic depressive insanity depressive state melancholia gravis, and manic depressive insanity depressive state melancholia simplex. In revised CODE-DD mixed state depressive excitement is characterised by anxious mood (depressed mood) with constricted thinking, driven complaintiveness and motor restlessness; manic depressive insanity paranoid depressive state by anxious mood (depressed mood) with disturbance of concentration (retarded thinking), abulia (asthenia), lack of drive (motor retardation)and ideas of reference (suspiciousness), delusions and mood congruent psychotic symptoms; manic depressive insanity depressive state melancholia gravis by anxious mood (depressed mood) with disturbance of concentration (retarded thinking), abulia (asthenia), lack of drive (motor retardation) and delusions (hallucinations), bodily misperceptions and self-incrimination; manic depressive insanity depressive state melancholia simplex by anxious mood (depressed mood) with disturbance of concentration (retarded thinking), abulia (asthenia) and lack of drive (motor retardation).
