5. MANIA/ HYPOMANIA

Present, stop Absent, stop PSYCHIATRIC DISORDER DEPRESSIVE TEMPERAMENT

It consists of a total number of 6 digits based on 6 codes included in 5 variables organized into 3 decision clusters, yielding 1 diagnosis.

It is based on Ernst Kretschmer's book *Physique and Character*, written by 1925, in which he postulates that the Melancholic Temperament is characterized by sad mood or grief, associated to psychic tempo retardation, motor retardation and abnormal sensitivity to psychic stimulation. In revised CODE-DD Depressive Temperament is characterized depressed mood, with retarded thinking, constricted affect and motor retardation.
