## JOHANNES LANGE'S CRITERIA OF PSYCHOGENIC DEPRESSION

## 1. DEPRESSED MOOD

Present, proceed to 2 Absent, stop

Possible Psychogenic Depression PSYCHIATRIC DISORDER

- 2. PRECIPITATING FACTOR
- 3. DEPRESSIVE SYNDROME IN TEMPORAL CONNECTION WITH PRECIPITATING FACTOR

Both present, proceed to 4 Less than 2 present, stop Possible Psychogenic Depression PSYCHIATRIC DISORDER

- 4. ASTHENIA
- 5. IRRITABILITY
- 6. ABULIA

All 3 present, proceed to 7 Less than 3 present, stop

Probable Psychogenic Depression PSYCHIATRIC DISORDER

7. MANIA/ HYPOMANIA

Present, stop Absent, stop PSYCHIATRIC DISORDER
PSYCHOGENIC DEPRESSION

It consists of a total of 8 digits, based on 8 codes included in 7 variables organized into 4 decision clusters, yielding 1 diagnosis.

It is based on Johannes Lange's paper published under the title "Ueber melancholie" in the *Zeitschrift fur die gesamte Neurologie und Psychiatrie* in 1926 in which psychogenic depression was described as a depression with fatigue, irritability and inability to get going at work. In revised CODE-DD depressed mood, asthenia, irritability and abulia, in temporal connection with a precipitating factor characterize it.
