

DIAGNOSTIC CRITERIA AND CLASSIFICATIONS

CODE(c)UD consists of a total of 85 entries: 62 classifications of unipolar depression and 23 specially devised diagnostic criteria of one or another of the different forms of unipolar depression.

The 85 entries of CODE(c)UD cover the conceptual development of melancholia from the Corpus Hippocraticum (460(c)370 BC) to the American Psychiatric Association's DSM(c)IVTR (2000) and the Latin(tm)American Guide to the ICD(c)10 (2003). The classifications/diagnostic criteria are presented in chronology, based, as much as possible, on the year of publication of the original source material.

The last two classifications on the list, the Composite Diagnostic Classification of Unipolar Depression and the Nosological Matrix for Unipolar Depression, were specially devised for use in clinical psychopharmacological and molecular genetic research.
