It consists of a total number of 20 digits, based on 15 codes included in 11 variables organised into 7 decision clusters, yielding to 3 diagnoses.

It is based on volume 2 of Jean-Etienne-Dominique Esquirol's *Des Maladies Mentales*, published in 1838 in which lypemania is separated from affective monomania and divided into lypemania with self-absorption and lypemania with despair. Lypemania in revised CODE-D is characterised by depressive evaluations and unmotivated depressed mood; and affective monomania is characterised by anxious mood (depressed mood), anguish (feeling of hopelessnes) and feeling of guilt (feeling of impoverishment, feeling of inadequacy, or self-incrimination).
