Less than 2 present, stop

3. WITHDRAWAL4. FEELING OF HOPELESSNESS5. ASTHENIA

5. ASTHENIA At least 2 of 3 present, proceed to 4

Less than 2 of 3, stop

Possible Sorrowful Melancholia PSYCHIATRIC DISORDER

Probable Sorrowful Melancholia PSYCHIATRIC DISORDER

6. MANIA/ HYPOMANIA

Present, stop Absent, stop PSYCHIATRIC DISORDER SORROWFUL MELANCHOLIA (DELUSIONS)

It consists of a total number of 7 digits based on 7 codes included in 6 variables organized into 3 decision clusters, yielding 1 diagnosis.

It is based on Ernst Feuchtersleben's 1845 book *The principles of Medical Psychology* in which Sorrowful Melancholia is described as sadness with a fixed partial delusion, withdrawal, hopelessness and debility. In revised CODE-DD Sorrowful melancholia is characterized by depressed mood and mood congruent psychotic symptoms with withdrawal, feeling of hopelessness and asthenia
